Like, come on, we should all have a vested interest in reducing the amount of gun violence in this nation, but some people think that you're infringing upon their rights. But you are infringing upon my right to live free and not feel terrorized by having all these guns.

Dr. VGP: You have outlined the right grassroot reality of what's happening on Capitol Hill today. Let's come back to the local scene of Chicago. You were the first and only Congressman backing Brandon Johnson, then Cook County Commissioner, who got elected as the mayor of the City of Chicago. You had the foresight and the vision, and out of all the candidates, you backed Brandon from day one.

Jonathan Jackson: Right.

Dr. VGP: What do you think Brandon is going to do for the city of Chicago?

Jonathan Jackson: Well, I backed him because I trust him the most; he was the hardest worker and he's the smartest, so it was easy for me to make that endorsement, so I've got extremely high hopes for Mayor Johnson; everyone does, and I want to make sure that people are pulling for him in the right direction. He has enormous challenges on his desk, so let me say we have enormous challenges on our desk. We have a shrinking city, we have a growing deficit, we've got a pension plan that's out of whack, and we've got 50 elementary schools that were closed 10 years ago, so we have fewer children in our publicschool system today than we did. Miami-Dade County's public-school system is now larger than the city of Chicago, the third-largest metropolitan city. Chicago has all of the wherewithal to have abundant natural resources; we don't have a water problem, many parts of the country have a water problem; we don't have a heat problem with an inhospitable

U.K. police arrest terror suspect China on 'high alert' after Canada who escaped from jail in London and U.S. ships transit Taiwan Strait



The U.K. police on Saturday arrested a terror suspect who escaped from a London prison earlier this week, sparking a nationwide manhunt. Daniel Khalife, a 21-yearold former soldier, fled from Wandsworth prison in south London on Wednesday morning, probably by clinging to the bottom of a delivery van.



China said on Saturday its troops were "on constant high alert" after two ships belonging to the U.S. and Canada transited through the Taiwan Strait. Beijing said that the two ships — identified only as Johnson of the U.S. and Ottawa of Canada — had "openly hyped up" their passage through the waters.
